4/16/2018 Council Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Scott Gauslow at 7:40PM. Present were Council Member Jeff Olson, Neil Berseth, Jody Lingen, Tom Wulfekuhle. City Auditor Susan Bowman was absent. Seri Moch was in attendance to take minutes for Susan. Also in attendance was John Erdahl, Sid Berg. Mayor Gauslow recognized the residents who were there to listen.

The minutes for March City Council Meeting were reviewed. Neil Berseth made motion, seconded by Tom Wulfekuhle to approve as presented; motion carried.

The Financial report for the month of March was reviewed; Jeff Olson made motion, seconded by Jody Lingen to approve the report, motion carried.

The bills for the month of April were reviewed. Neil Berseth made a motion to approve the bills as presented, seconded by Jody Lingen; motion carried. Generator bill was presented by Mayor Gauslow for 712.89, decision was made to wait for the job to be completed before bill is paid.

Discussion on new city street light to be place on Reilands/football field corner.

Council discussed the City of Colfax roads and agreed to look into forming a 3 man committee to discuss the pavement of Grant Street.
